Re: Rearrangement of Class Schedule and Provisions on Modes of Instruction Delivery

Pertaining to the Situation on the Outbreak of COVID – 19

With reference to the announcement of the University No. 14 / 2020 dated 25 February 2020 and in complicance to the Approval of the Cabinet on March 17, 2020 on the provisions regarding the control of the outbreak of COVID – 19, the University remains committed on providing appropriate quality of living of students and, meanwhile, steadfastly adheres to the objectives of providing effective and efficient quality of instruction. The University announces the following rearrangement of class schedule and provisions on modes of instruction delivery pertaining to the situation on the outbreak of COVID – 19.

- 1. For all present students including those newly enrolled students of the academic year of 2020 21 the Summer Session will start on April 20, 2020 and end on June 3, 2020
- 2. The first Semester of the Academic Year of 2020 21 will start on June 15, 2020 onwards.
- 3. Modes of instruction delivery would be adapted or adjusted to the provisions of on-line instruction; that is, Microsoft Team, Mycourseville, MOOCs would be implemented and / or incorporated with assignment based. A class attendance would be required as necessary on project-based and case study-based.
- 4. Students could apply for residency at the residence halls of the University or resume their residency from Monday 23 March 2020 onwards. All students residing at the residence halls are subject to physical health check at every entrance of the residence hall.
